Eligibility

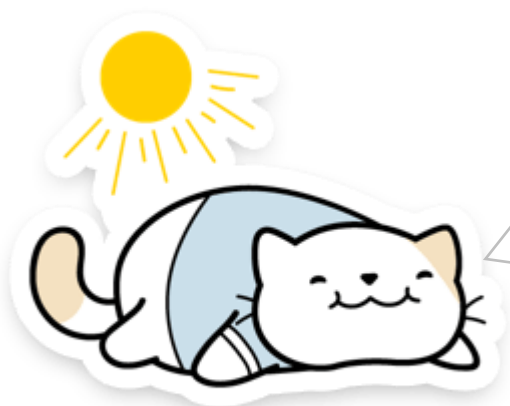
Regular international students of The University of Osaka who fall under one of the following categories

Undergraduate students:
Second or third year

Master's students: First year

Doctoral students: First or second year

For four-year doctoral programs (e.g., the Graduate School of Medicine), students in their second and third doctoral years (D2 and D3) are eligible to apply.
